Experience requirements for extending a Part-66 Aircraft Maintenance Licence

The experience requirements for adding a new category or subcategory to an existing Part-66 licence. The experience must be practical maintenance experience on operating aircraft in the subcategory relevant to the application. The experience requirement will be reduced by 50 % if the applicant has completed an approved Part-147 course relevant to the subcategory.
