Issue of multi-pilot type rating after ZFTT

After completion of training the following documents have to be sent to FOCA:


Original document (all pages), <u>completed</u> and signed by training organisation, candidate and examiner
□ FOCA form 60.530
□ or other appropriate EASA form issued by the responsible NAA
Copy of the EASA examiner certificate and licence (not required for Swiss examiners)
Copy of the EASA simulator qualification certificate (not required for Swiss simulators)
Copy of the EASA approval certificate (including approval for ZFTT) issued for the training organisation (not required for Swiss ATOs)
Copy of the agreement for ZFTT between ATO and EASA AOC-holder responsible for LIFUS (not required for Swiss ATOs, not applicable if ATO is the holder of an Air Operator Certificate (AOC) and will be responsible for Line Flying under Supervision).
Copy of the course completion certificate including the training records
Copy of the last 4 pages of the pilot logbook
Copy of the Swiss licence with a valid endorsement of language proficiency or the confirmation of passed Language Proficiency Check.
Copy of the valid EASA medical certificate (not applicable for holders of Swiss medical certificate)

Foreign examiners have to follow the procedure published by EASA in the "Examiner Differences Document"

The type rating will be restricted to operator responsible for Line Flying under Supervision (LIFUS), until the LIFUS has been accomplished.

To remove this restriction the confirmation (FOCA form 60.537) of the completion of LIFUS has to be sent to FOCA (either immediately after the LIFUS or together with documents for the first revalidation of the rating).
