



Issue of class or type rating contained in a non JAA/EASA licence into an EASA-FCL licence

Flight experience and conditions before skill test:

Valid type rating in non-EASA licence

Current flying practice on the relevant type or class

Flight experience:

- for type rating MNM 500 HR as pilot in that type
- for class rating MNM 100 HR as pilot in that class

Fulfilled requirements for the issue of that class or type rating in accordance with EASA Part FCL

List of documents to be sent to FOCA after the skill test:

- Skill-test form:
 - for multi-pilot type rating FOCA form 60.530 EASA
 - for single-pilot type rating high performance complex aeroplane FOCA form 60.526 EASA
 - for single-pilot class or type rating non-complex aeroplane FOCA form 60.525 EASA
- Copy of the EASA examiner certificate and licence (not required for Swiss examiners)
- Copy of the valid simulator's EASA certificate, if applicable (not required for Swiss simulators)
- Copies of the logbook confirming required flight experience and current flying practice
- Copy of the valid non-EASA licence and accompanying medical certificate
- Copy of the Swiss licence with a valid endorsement of language proficiency or the confirmation of passed Language Proficiency Check.
- Copy of the valid EASA medical certificate (not applicable for holders of Swiss medical certificate)

Foreign examiners have to follow the procedure published by EASA in “Examiner Differences Document”
