Important notes

The aircraft will only be deregistered once the FOCA is in possession of the originals of the Certificate of Registration and the Certificate of Airworthiness, or of the aircraft's permit to fly. Before an Export Certificate of Airworthiness can be issued, an official Conformity Inspection has to be performed on the aircraft. The aircraft holder should schedule this inspection with the FOCA in good time. Once the aircraft has been deregistered, the FOCA will no longer be able to issue statements and certificates relating to this aircraft. If the aircraft is to be exported, the relevant customs authorities must be contacted. Fees will apply in accordance with the Ordinance of 28 September 2007 on fees levied by the Federal Office of Civil Aviation (SR 748.112.11).

The following documents must be enclosed with the application:

- → Certificate of Registration
- → Certificate of Airworthiness/ permit to fly
